

## USING THE WASHING GUN

- 1. Connect the washing gun to air compressor via suitable hose.
- 2. Pour some appropriate amount of neutral detergent or hydrolytic thinner into the container.
- 3. Connect gun body with container tightly and aim the nozzle to parts chat you want to clean.
- 4. Adjustment of fluid.
- 5. Drain, clean and dry the solvent chamber after use and before storage.

**WARNING**: Avoid the use of highly inflammable solvent. Do not use to spray petrol. Non flammable commecial degreasers and detergents should be used. Never use corrosive detergent.

# **MAINTENANCE**

- ➤ Keep it clean. Regularly lubricate the moving parts of the trigger.
- > Equipment store in a dry area, protected from the weather.
- > Stored near chemicals and gases, causing corrosion is inaccessible.

To prevent damage to the unit during transport, pack it securely and use the original packaging.
